Warmherzig und klug – ein autofiktionaler Roman, der uns ins Erleben einer jungen hochfunktionalen Autistin mitnimmt.

Tris ist anders: Sie führt Listen, auf denen sie Wörter katalogisiert, um das Verhalten ihrer Mitmenschen zu verstehen; sie zählt laut Dinge in ihrer Umgebung, buchstabiert rückwärts und hält Vorträge über Lurche oder mathematische Formeln, wenn jemand ein Gespräch mit ihr versucht. Manchmal wartet sie auch mit sehr spezifischen, nicht themenverwandten Informationen auf – dass 2018 in Argentinien 51,59 Millionen mehr Rinder geschlachtet wurden als in Österreich, zum Beispiel. Blickkontakt mit ihrem Gegenüber verschiebt sie auf dessen Ellbogen und Körperkontakt mündet in Schreiattacken oder Ohnmachtsanfällen – dann tut sich Tris' innerer Marianengraben auf und zieht sie hinab. Dabei möchte sie eigentlich vor allem eins: dazugehören. Dieses Ziel verfolgt Tris hartnäckig auf ihrer skurril-komischen und mitunter tieftraurigen Reise durch eine Welt, für die sie einfach nicht gemacht zu sein scheint.

Mit viel Wärme, wunderbaren Bildern und subtilem Humor gelingt es Nicole Balschun, uns ganz nah am Erleben, Denken und Empfinden einer hochfunktionalen Autistin teilhaben zu lassen. Tris' Geschichte berührt, weil sie in einem ganz eigenen Ton erzählt wird, mit klugen Gedanken und einer großen Leichtigkeit.

In einer losen Fortsetzung, nimmt Tris ein Studium auf, beginnt ihren ersten Job in einem Bestattungsunternehmen – die Freundschaft zum uralten Eigentümer Herrn Rosenbaum ist wunderbar schräg und zart – und sie erlebt, was es heißt, verliebt zu sein...

Nicole Balschun, 1975 in Ostfriesland geboren, ist eine deutsche Schriftstellerin. Im Sommer 2024 erhielt sie das Spreewald-Literaturstipendium. Ihr Romandebüt *Ada Liebt* erschien 2011 bei Dumont. Balschun ist promovierte Literaturwissenschaftlerin und zudem seit 2005 als Lehrerin an Förderschulen für verhaltensauffällige Kinder und Jugendliche tätig. Sie lebt mit ihrer Familie in Hannover.
